## Construction

• GRP / Balsa sandwich hull built with the infusion process, for an optimum resin / fibre ratio.

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- Hull protected by the use of bisphenolic resin on the external layers of the sandwich.
- One-piece composite structure integrating lateral and longitudinal reinforcements glassed and bonded to the bottom, spreading the rig and appendages efforts throughout the hull.
- GRP/Balsa sandwich deck fitted on the hull via polyurethane bonding and mechanical fastening at bulwark level.
- Iron bulb keel, fastened with stainless steel bolts, nuts and counterplates.
- Cable transmission steering system with 2 steering wheels; composite rudder shaft, needle bearings.

# Spars and rigging

- Anodized aluminium Sparcraft Performance (or similar) mast.
- 3 sets of aft swept spreaders.
- Anodized aluminium Sparcraft (or similar) boom with outhaul, 2 automatic and one manual reefs.
- Rigid boom vang.
- Facnor (or similar) genoa furler.
- Single strand stainless steel standing rigging: double backstay, main forestay, lower, intermediate and upper shrouds.
- Running rigging: Main halyard (Dyneema) and genoa halyard (Vectran), boom topping lift, main and genoa sheet outhaul, 3 reefs and genoa furler adjusting line.

#### **Deck fittings**

- Harken ball bearing blocks. Spinlock deck stoppers.
- $\bullet$  2 Andersen 52 ST FS 2-speed primary winches close to steering stations.

- 2 Andersen 46 ST FS 2-speed manoeuvring winches close to steering stations.
- Mainsheet led back to manoeuvring winches.
- 2 Harken genoa tracks with adjustable car.
- Turning blocks at mast step and cockpit levels as necessary.

#### **Mooring equipment**

- Delta 25KG anchor with 50 m / 12 mm chain and 50m warp.
- 4 mooring lines (black)
- 6 fenders + 6 fender socks (black).

# Deck equipment

- Teak cockpit seats and floor.
- Tender garage with tilting aft platform (electric assistance option available).
- Removable stainless steel swim ladder.
- Liferaft stowage on pushpits.
- 2 steering positions with dedicated space for electronics, engine control and engine panel on starboard.
- 1 compass mounted on cockpit table.
- Emergency tiller.
- 1 gear locker under cockpit seat.
- 1 gas locker under cockpit seat.
- Winch handle boxes.
- Cold molded teak cockpit table with 2 folding leaves, fitted on stainless steel support.
- 3 large opening ports for light and ventilation in the aft cabin.
- Bulwark with solid teak cover and 6 stainless steel custom fairleads.
- 6 stainless steel mooring cleats.
- Stainless steel fresh water and fuel filler caps.
- 2-part stainless steel aft pulpit with 2 closing wires, outboard engine support.

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- Flagstaff bracket on deck.
- "Open" type stainless steel bow pulpit.
- Double stainless steel lifelines.
- Stainless steel stanchion with lateral opening gates.
- 2 deck lifelines with folding pad eyes.
- 2 folding pad eyes for life-jacket in the cockpit.
- 2 stainless steel handrails on cabin top.
- Large stained lateral windows in PMMA with teak louver, 8 opening ports.
- Panoramic stained PMMA windshield.
- 8 opening deck hatches, 11 opening portholes, 7 fixed hull portholes.
- 2 dorade boxes on coachroof and 2 integrated dorades for aft cabin for inside ventilation, stainless steel protection for the 2 front ones
- Sail locker forward, grating and electric bilge pump.
- Self-raining anchor locker with hook and sail bag attaching rod, 1500 W windlass with vertical gipsy for 12 mm chain.
- Stainless steel protection forward of chain locker.
- Stainless steel bow fitting with 2 rollers and Gennaker fixing.
- Shore-power outlet with connection cable.
- Shore fresh water inlet.

#### Inside accommodations

- The interior woodwork is built in teak and beeswaxed. The floorboard is made in laminate wengé. The deck is doubled with a GRP liner. The hull liner is covered by vinyl.
- For an outstanding comfort mattresses and cushions are made of high-density foam. All berths are equipped with a slatted base and lee cloths and have cold molded teak fiddles around the beddings.

# Companionway

- Stained PMMA hatch boards with lock and in-deck recessed storage.
- Stained PMMA sliding companionway hatch.
- Curved laminated teak steps with non-skid inserts.
- 2 stainless steel handrails (leather wrapped).
- Wet locker to starboard.

## Saloon

- Single level saloon with panoramic vision either standing or seated, at the dining table or at the chart table.
- Large engine room and technical compartment below saloon with hinges and levers on floorboards.
- "U" shaped dinette to starboard with cabinetwork dining table.
- Bar and numerous lockers under seats and behind backrests.
- Settee / Navigator's seat to port with stowage under the seats and behind the backrests.
- Chart table with chart stowing space, bookrack, lockers and reading lights.

- Panel for navigation electronics in teak with a leather belt.
- 4 large opening hatches and 8 lateral opening ports.
- Large locker to starboard for optional washing machine.

#### Galley to port

- The galley has an "L" shape and is located in a gangway to port of the companionway.
- Synthetic marble double sink with mixer tap.
- Large synthetic marble working countertops.
- Stainless steel 3 burner gimballed stove with oven.
- Solenoid safety valve for gas circuit.
- 12 V refrigerator (140 I / 37 US Gal.approx.)
- 100l icebox (12 V negative temperature option available).
- Cutlery drawer, large pots and pans drawer, various lockers and storage spaces, waste bin.
- Opening port above galley.
- Exclusive Wauquiez crockery for 6 persons.

#### Cabin(s) aft of saloon

- Choice of 2 alternative layouts:
- a) Owner's aft cabin (standard version)
- Large lit hanging locker to port and storage alongside the hull. Centreline bed (2,05 x 1,60 m). Bed tilts up on gas springs to allow access to storage under. Vanity to starboard with table and mirror. Numerous lockers and storage spaces.
- 3 large opening ports into the cockpit, 4 fixed hull portholes.

Or

b) 2 guest cabins (option)

- Aft cabin to Starboard with double lateral bed, drawers under the bed, hanging locker to port, lockers and storage, 2 cockpit opening portholes and 2 hull fixed portholes.
- Double cabin to Port with 2 superimposed berths, hanging locker, lockers, shelves alongside the hull, 1 cockpit opening porthole and 2 hull fixed portholes.

#### Aft bathroom

- Synthetic marble washbassin with mixer tap.
- Cabinet with mirror.
- Marine toilet (large model).
- Independent shower with grating and draining electric pump.
- 1 opening deck hatch, 1 opening porthole.

# Cabin(s) forward of saloon

- Choice of 2 alternative layouts:
- a) 2 guest cabins forward of saloon (standard version)
- Double cabin to starboard with 2 superimposed berths, 1 large locker with shelves, lockers under berth, shelves alongside the hull, 1 opening hatch and 1 fixed hull porthole.
- Forward cabin with double centre bed, drawers under the bed, hanging locker to port, lockers and storage, 1 large opening hatch and 2 fixed hull portholes.

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b) 1 owner's aft cabin (option)

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- Large owner's cabin with lateral double bed to starboard, drawers under the bed, double hanging locker, lockers, shelves alongside the hull, settee and desk, 2 opening hatches and 1 fixed hull porthole, lee clothes.
- Curtains / blinds on all portholes.
- Skyscreen-flyscreens on all opening hatches.

# Guest's bathroom to port

- Synthetic marble washbasin with mixer tap.
- Cabinet with mirror.
- Marine toilet (large model).
- Independent shower with grating and draining electric pump.
- 1 opening port & 1 hull fixed porthole.

# **Engine equipment**

- YANMAR 110 HP engine.
- 12 V / 125 Amp. alternator
- Propeller shaft protected by external skeg.
- 3 bladed fixed propeller.
- 650 I / 172 US Gal. approx. fuel tank with decanter filter.
- 75 Amp engine start battery.
- Lit engine room with themric/sound insulation.

#### **Electrics**

- 12 V. service circuit with 3 X 135 Amp. gel batteries.
- Shore power outlet with 12 V / 50 Amp. battery charger.
- 12V / 230 V (or 12V / 115V) electric panel with touchscreen control interface (can be controlled remotely from a smartphone). Installed at chart table.
- Ceiling recessed LED lighting throughout.
- Reading lights at each bed, in the saloon and at the chart table.

# Plumbing / Fresh Water

- Total capacity of 615 I / 162 US Gal. approx. With electric gauge under the floorboards, dock fresh water inlet.
- $\bullet$  40 l / 11 US Gal. approx. water heater working from engine or from 220 V. circuit.
- 12 V water system.
- Electric draining pumps in shower compartments.
- Cockpit shower cold/hot water.

# **Black waters**

• 2 x 80 l / 21 US Gal. approx. holding tank for toilets.


## **Draining**

- Self-draining cockpit and chain locker.
- Electric automatic bilge pump with manual switch at electric panel.
- Double effect manual bilge pump in the cockpit.
- Electric automatic bilge pumps in tender garage and in sail locker.
